The Sirocco range derives from non European cattle. Due to its nature, the hides might have brandings and marks and a hole in the neck area.

It is a chrome tanned corrected grain upholstery leather suitable for domestic usage, but can be treated for contract use.

The average thickness is 0.9 - 1.1mm. Average hide size of 4.3 - 5.0 square metres.

## What you should know about ordering leather

Due to the beautiful natural characteristics of leather, there may be some variation in shade and texture within a hide, and between hides. Although hides are free from excessive scars, there is always some evidence of their natural origin. Size will also vary between hides, but a typical hide is between 4.5 -5.5m<sup>2</sup>. Please contact us for sizes available.

Samples are a good guide to colour and finish, but you should bear in mind an exact match cannot be guaranteed.
